SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 754 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, next item.

CLERK: LB 208. Senator Mossey, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7094, Legislative Journal page 1113.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of E & R amendments to LB 208

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Kruse has AM1632. Senator, I have a note that you'd like to withdraw AM1632 and offer as a substitute AM1774. (Legislative Journal page 1675.)

SENATOR KRUSE: That is correct.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Seeing no objection, so ordered.

CLERK: Senator Kruse, AM1774.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kruse to open on AM1774 to LB 208.

SENATOR KRUSE: Thank you, Mr. President and members. This is the people friendly bill. And we demand equal time with livestock. (Laugh) We've already spent nearly three hours discussing this bill. So I would say that's probably quite a bit. But I appreciate the discussion that's gone on. We have...I or my staff has talked with every person who made suggestions during the General File stage, and this amendment represents the negotiations that have taken place around those discussions.
