are on their own. I'm not a part of that. For me, we've reworked this many times, and I stand by this product. And final comment; we have a news report from the National Transportation Safety Board, in which they declare that hard-core drivers are the ones who are nearly double the legal limit. That's the ones we're focusing on. And I encourage us to continue to focus on it. And I would invite other ideas as we move through the interim. I do not want to be the person that carries this kind of thing. That's not who I am.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR KRUSE: But the national board is saying this is something we should take into concern. They have also announced that they are going to focus on repeat offenders. This will be a national push. And part of it is to have a new charge for hard-core offenders called aggravated DUI. Well, friends, that's in our bill. We're ahead of it. It's going to be compulsory after awhile. We're doing it while we can volunteer to do it. I commend the amendment to the body and ask for your vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Kruse. (Visitors introduced.) Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have some amendments to the... Senator Kruse's amendment. The first, Senator Synowiecki, you had AM1777, but I have a note you'd like to withdraw that.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Foley. Senator, I had AM1776, again with a note you want to withdraw AM1776.

SENATOR FOLEY: And substitute...

CLERK: Senator, I won't need to do that, because you're the next one after that, if that's okay.
