SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. Senator Tyson on the Foley amendment. Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Question, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, should debate cease on AM1806, offered by Senator Foley to AM1774? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on ceasing debate on the Foley amendment to the Kruse amendment to LB 208. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. Senator Foley to close on your amendment, AM1806. Senator Foley.

SENATOR FOLEY: Yes. Thank you, Mr. President and members. Senator Bourne had asked me as a courtesy to give him a minute or so. So let me give him the minute and then do my closing, please. I yield to Senator Bourne.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Thank you, Senator Foley. Actually, Senator Foley offered me a minute, which I appreciate. I'm going to support Senator Foley's amendment to this bill.
