for that when I came to the Legislature, but I take seriously my responsibility, if nobody does what he or she should do on this floor as a responsible legislator, I am. And if it angers everybody on the floor, get angry. I am irritated and annoyed and exasperated at all the dumping that goes on to me session after session after session. And I'm going to let you all know how I feel about it. So when I have to undertake the job of stopping a bill because others will not assume their responsibility, don't one of you come to me and say, mercy, mercy. Don't one of you come to me and say, you shouldn't do it. And don't one of you come to me, whose bill I may attack, come to me and say, you're connecting two issues. No. I see it as a seamless web. You're going to dump this trash on me, then I'm going to trash your bills, and make you come to an understanding of the fact that you have a responsibility on this bad legislation also.

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And I will make you assume that responsibility, one way or the other. Or if I fail, everything on the docket is fair game for me. And when we have ten days left, time is on my side. I have endured 80 days. Do you think I'm going to collapse in the last ten? Senator Mossey was a track man. Senator Mossey, when does the sprint come? It comes at the end of the race, and you run faster then than you did at any other part of the race. I pace myself. I'm ready. And this bill may as well be the first one. It ought to be bracketed...it ought to be killed. But Senator Bourne is saying, bracket it, and allow Senator Kruse the opportunity to do something with it, and the bill will come up first thing next session. But right now, I'm in the frame of mind where I don't care what you do. I'm going to vote for the bracket. But I don't care what you all do. I will not let you pass this bill. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Tyson on the bracket motion.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. Were I Senator Kruse right now, I probably would feel a deep
