time. And if someone yields to you time, that's a second opportunity to speak, which is forbidden by the rules, again, in Section 12, on page 4. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Each member can speak one time to that. Is there anybody wishing to talk to the Bourne challenge of the Chair ruling? Senator Bourne. Senator Raikes.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I agree with Senator Bourne, which means I am going to support overruling the Chair on this, the first motion, even though I'm not going to support it on the second motion. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator. Thank you, Senator Raikes. Senator Stuthman.

SENATOR STUTHMAN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker and members of the body. I, too, also will support Senator Bourne's clarification on his overruling of the Chair. I think it is just as plain as day. It says no member may speak more than once. That means if we listen to an individual one time, we can't listen to them again. Once is once, period. Thank you.
