It is withdrawn, Senator Foley. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Raikes would move to amend LB 249.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, to open on AM1779 to LB 249.

SENATOR RAIKES: Mr. President, I would like to withdraw that amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn also.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have nothing further pending to LB 249.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Open for discussion on advancement of LB 249 to E & R for engrossing. Open for discussion. There are no lights on. Senator Friend, you're recognized for a motion.

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you, Mr. President. I move the advancement of LB 249 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion by Senator Friend to advance LB 249, E & R to engrossing. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed to the motion say nay. It is advanced. Speaker Bromm, did you wish to speak?

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. This has been a very hard week and a very . . . a great deal has been accomplished and I just want to commend the body for sticking with it and working several days in a row very, very hard. We've got a couple of weeks of probably pretty hard work left. I just want to give you a little heads up. The agenda is coming out a little bit late, but it should be out by the time you leave the Chamber here. We're going to do some senator priority bills on Monday that are represented to be bills that may not have a great deal of controversy. There's never a guarantee on that, of course. We'll also have some committee priority bills that were first choice committee priority bills that need to get handled, and we'll try to . . . that will take up, I think, most of the day.
