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LB 43, 133, 438

Section 12 of the amendment, is what was LB 133 by Senator Thompson. Section 12 clarifies custody procedures when a probation officer is determining the need for detention of a juvenile. When a juvenile is taken into temporary custody and a decision needs to be made to determine whether detention is or is not appropriate, the peace officer, when necessary, shall bring the juvenile to the probation officer for such determination. The probation officer, after the detention determination is made, shall find and secure appropriate placement for the juvenile. If necessary, the peace officer shall transport the juvenile to the...for the purposes of placement. As Senator Thompson has indicated, both Senator Beutler's bill and her bill incorporated within this Judiciary Committee amendment were advanced 7-0. I urge your adoption of the amendment and your advancement of Senator Thompson's LB 43, and if either Senator Thompson or Senator Beutler would give me an indication, I would be pleased to yield time to them for their purposes. No. That concludes my opening. Thank you, Mr. President.
