SENATOR THOMPSON: That's a determination of the prosecutor whether...the determination...I don't...let me just review this here. The number...on line 28, it would...the county attorney may use the following information: the nature of the offense and the role of the juvenile in the offense; the number and nature of previous offenses involving the juvenile; the dangerousness or threat posed...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR THOMPSON: ...by the juvenile.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Let me...let me...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler.

SENATOR THOMPSON: I don't...I don't know if we have that language in here, but that...I...that would be...one of the issues that we had in developing the bill was not taking away too far from the county attorney in his or her prosecutorial role to be able to make some of those determinations.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Okay. And last question...well, a couple questions, I guess. Down on page 3, line 24, it requires the confidentiality of information. And since I've been involved with the Program Evaluation Committee I've taken note of this continual language here and there with respect to confidentiality and how that might relate...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...to the Program Evaluation Committee.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Your time is up, Senator Beutler.
