SENATOR CUDABACK: ...Tyson.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...Tyson, just for clarification purposes

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Tyson, will you respond?

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay. So we...could we be the only state that's adopted this?
