process. And simply tailoring the bill a little bit tighter to the stated objectives of the bill. It's not meant to be adversarial in any way. And I don't think that it is. But it will hold the court system to the purposes which it itself defined. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. You've heard the closing on AM2004, offered by Senator Beutler to LB 760. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of AM2004, offered by Senator Beutler to LB 760. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Beutler's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, would you restate the motion, please.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 760 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, your light just came on. Did you wish to address the motion?

SENATOR RAIKES: Yes, I did, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You may do so at this time.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I have probably fallen further behind than the rest. But this is somewhat of a significant change in the court fee structure. And I would just like to have Senator Brashear explain, sort of from beginning to end, what the fee is right now, what it would be if all of this package were adopted, what components this
