SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the opening on AM1499. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Bromm. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM1499 to LB 209. All in favor of the amendment vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on the adoption of AM1499, offered by Senator Bromm to LB 209. Has everybody voted who cares to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 26 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 209 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It's been moved to advance LB 209. Open for discussion. Senator Bromm.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Members, this is one of those bills that kind of slips through. But I can tell you that...again, I'll remind from General File, Senator Connealy and Senator Chambers, Senator Wehrbein, Senator Vrtiska, staffs, this bill was worked on an awful lot by DMV and others through the summer. There was a terrific study done which analyzes this whole area of the law. It's important that we make the changes that are implemented in LB 209, and we straighten out the process. Otherwise, we'll continue to have not only financial questions continue to come up from claims that are filed, but also I think it isn't the best process for the citizens right now.
