SENATOR BEUTLER: And what are the dimensions of this deal? You and Senator Bromm, are others committed to this? Are all other amendments out or what...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: One minute.

SENATOR BEUTLER: ...what's...

SENATOR LANDIS: Senator Bromm...I have to confess it's late breaking and perhaps a friendly motion to lay it over for a day for us to all think about it might be wise, but Senator Bromm and I...I'm in agreement with Senator Bromm and I think Senator Bromm is the holder of the understanding. I think that would be a fair characterization. That sound fair?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Bromm, what is...what are the dimensions of the understanding as far as your commitment to this amendment goes?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Bromm.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Is this to be the only amendment to the bill, for example?

SPEAKER BROMM: I think the understanding that I have is that the other provisions of the bill go away, LB 270 is repealed, and the rural tier amendment is put in place, and the other issues wait for another day. I think that's the essence of it.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Time.

SPEAKER BROMM: You're not...that is, Senator Landis...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Time, Senator Bromm.

SPEAKER BROMM: ...and I have worked on this, our understanding. That certainly doesn't bind you, Senator Beutler.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Senators Beutler, Bromm and Landis, and the Chair would like to recognize that she misidentified Senator Vrtiska as Senator Wehrbein a few minutes ago. The next
