SENATOR SCHIMEK: All...the motion is to advance to E & R engrossing. All in favor say aye. Oh, I'm sorry. Any discussion? Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER: My light was on from last time, Speaker. I do not wish to speak.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Erdman, did you wish to speak?

SENATOR ERDMAN: I did, Madam President. If I could ask somebody...maybe Senator Chambers. If I could ask Senator Chambers a question.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Chambers, would you yield to a question?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I believe that I will.

SENATOR ERDMAN: I appreciate your collegiality, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'm known for that. (Laughter)

SENATOR ERDMAN: We had discussed LB...yes, you are. We have been discussing this on General File. And the strategy that was employed at the time was that this bill would advance to whatever stage, that individuals could have an opportunity to round up the troops, if you will, and kind of talk about the idea of term limits. Is it your understanding that that is going on?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I haven't been told of anything that has happened. So when you say "round up the troops," you mean as far as senators on the floor? Or groups outside that want to work on this?

SENATOR ERDMAN: Groups outside that wanted to discuss the effects of term limits.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: None of those groups had contacted me at all. But Senator Engel, I think, and others, had mentioned that some
