CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to cease debate.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Debate does cease. The motion was successful. Senator Tyson, you're recognized.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President. Senator Chambers, for a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, would you respond?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Yes I will.

SENATOR TYSON: Have you had an opportunity to file your motion?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Tyson, it's too late. When the question has been called, it's...you can't file a motion. So it got by me. We won't have a chance to do anything other than vote to advance your bill.

SENATOR TYSON: Okay. Ladies and gentlemen of the body, all I can do...we've had a good discussion. A lot of the aspects of term limits have been discussed. I think that this is the time, regardless of what some people may say in the public pulse or over the radio, for us to exercise leadership. I intend to do that by voting for the advance of LB 598. I urge all of you to do the same. Thank you very much.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on the advancement of LB 598. Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 598 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 598 for a motion. There's been a request for a board vote. The question before the body is advancement of LB 598, E & R for engrossing. Senator Chambers, I think your hand was up first.
