LB 439, 598

You request a what? There's been a request for a call of the house. All in favor of the house going under call vote aye, and opposed nay. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, to place the house under call.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Bromm, would you check in, please? Senator Johnson, would you check in, please? The house is under call. Senator Stuhr, Senator Landis, Senator Quandahl, Senator Synowiecki, Senator Thompson, Senator Bourne. Senator Landis, the house is under call. Members, would you please take your seat? The house is under call. Members, the house is under call. Thank you. All members present or accounted for. The question before the body is advancement of LB 598, E & R for engrossing. There has been a request for a roll call vote in regular order. Mr. Clerk, call the roll on that question, please.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1929.)
30 ayes, 8 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to advance LB 598.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. LB 598 advances to E & R for engrossing. I do raise the call. We now go to Select File, 2003 Speaker priority bill. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next bill is LB 439. I have no Enrollment and Review amendments. The bill was bracketed until April 24. When the Legislature left the issue, there was pending AM1384, offered by Senator Beutler and others. Senator, I have a note here that you would like to withdraw AM1384, and offer as a substitute AM1971. (Legislative Journal page 1929.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Without objection, so ordered. Senator...is that true?

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, you're recognized to open on
