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it, any of these people at this particular point are under the DAS. Is that right?

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right.

SENATOR VRTISKA: And so what you're saying is, if I understand it right, you're taking money that is now being appropriated from DAS, and you're going to put it into the Office of an Administrator, and he's going to be in charge of whatever areas of this building need to be taken care of. Is that correct?

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's right. He or she.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Okay. Well, yes, he or she. Well, you know, when I first saw this, I became...I wasn't happened to be there the day this was heard. And I did talk to Senator Schimek and others about this idea. And at that particular time, my concerns were, obvious, as anybody else's, is that we were going to have to raise a considerable amount of money to hire more people to do the things done. If I understand it correctly now, you say there won't be any more money, at least at this point. There will only be the same money that's there, but other people are going to be appointed. And I guess what I'm...the question that I'm trying to get to, if you're appointing these people and they meet all the qualifications, I don't know what they get now, but can you hire people, as administrator over the whole program, for that kind of money?

SENATOR BEUTLER: People who are involved in the program think absolutely we can, that it's a position that would be treasured by a number of people. There would be people willing to do this particular job maybe for less than what they could make elsewhere. And none of the people involved in this are concerned about getting a good person to do this job.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Well, they should run for the state Legislature, if they're so willing to...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yeah.

SENATOR VRTISKA: ...donate their time. (Laugh) But seriously,
