SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Foley. Mr. Clerk, anything else on the bill? Senator Brashear, to close on the amendment.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, I have summarized the amendment. The amendment deals with the excusing of nursing mothers from jury duty for the period that they are nursing if they so elect. It allows judges in counties of over 200,000 inhabitants to determine whether the jury commissioner will be the clerk of the district court or the election commissioner. And it also eliminates a, in my opinion, severely outdated cost bond requirement for nonresidents of Nebraska, which has been supplanted and obviated by other legislation. I urge the adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. You've heard the closing on AM1527. The question is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of AM1527 to LB 19. Record please, Mr. Clerk.
