SENATOR CUDABACK: Any discussion on the amendment? Seeing no lights on, Senator Chambers. He waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM2003 to LB 320. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of AM2003 to LB 320, offered by Senator Chambers. Have you all voted who wish to? Record please, Mr. Clerk

CLERK: 35 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted. Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 320E to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt .to advance LB 320E to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is readvanced. Mr. Clerk, next. We are passing over LB 320AE. As the agenda states, General File appropriation bills, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, on General File, LB 95A, a bill by Senator Byars. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Byars, to open on LB 95A

SENATOR BYARS: Thank you, Mr. President. This fairly simple A bill, it's all cash funded through fees from the Bureau of Examining Boards for the crematory bill, \$6,865 for the years 2003-2004, and \$5,150 from the Bureau of Examining Boards' cash fund on 2004-2005. So there are no General Fund dollars involved, and I would move that we advance LB 95A.
