SENATOR SCHIMEK: That's my understanding.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. There are no further lights on. Senator Schimek, did you wish to close on the committee amendment? She waives the opportunity to close. The question before the body is adoption of AM0415, offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee to LB 430. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is adoption of the committee amendment offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk, item on the desk.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend. (FA1386, Legislative Journal page 1970.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, you're recognized to open on your FA1386 to LB 430.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, this amendment is not yet on your gadget, but it's easy to understand. I want Senator Schimek to see if she might agree with this. It says that...and I'm going to have to paraphrase, because I don't have a copy. Oh, you can? Would you read it please?

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schimek, would you respond?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: It says...yes, thank you, Mr. President. It says, "The Secretary of State, whenever deemed appropriate for the facilitation of carrying out the duties of chief protocol officer, may designate himself or herself as Secretary of
