SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Don Pederson. Senator Engel.

SENATOR ENGEL: Mr. President, members of the body. Senator Chambers, if we were in South Carolina, we'd maybe call this the Secretary of Pork. But we're not there, so. I yield the rest of my time.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. There are no further lights on. Senator Chambers, did you wish to close on your amendment, FA1386?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, although Senator Don Pederson would like to tell me, why don't you stick a fork in it, I'm going to take this to a vote. I think we ought to adopt it. We're on General File. If, upon mature reflection, the body decides we ought to strip it, ...not a strip steak, Senator Bourne...then I would be willing to assist in taking it off. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on FA1386, offered by Senator Chambers to LB 430. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted?
