LB 608

SENATOR CUDABACK: That would be AM2014. The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on AM2014? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on ceasing debate on AM2014 to AM2005 to LB 608. Voting on ceasing debate. Have you all...motion before the body is ceasing debate on AM2014. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 26 ayes, 1 nay to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Debate has ceased. Senator Bromm, to close on AM2014 to AM2005 to LB 608. Senator Bromm, you're recognized to close.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Mr. President. Again, this amendment is not particularly substantive. It is a cleanup amendment which does clarify the disclosure portion to make it consistent with the LB 775 language. And it also provides that those people who are counting on the LB 270 program for this year, 2003, that the program continues through the end of the year and then it stops. So that's the two aspects of the amendment. I would ask for your support.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bromm. You've heard the closing on AM2014. The question before the body is, shall that amendment be adopted? All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the Bromm amendment to the Bromm amendment, AM2014. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted. Mr. Clerk, next amendment.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Senator Beutler would move to amend the Bromm amendment with AM2045. (Legislative Journal page 1978.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, to open on AM2045 to the Bromm amendment.
