SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to recess till 1:30 p.m. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed nay. We are recessed until one-thirty.

RECESS

SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Good afternoon. Welcome to the George W. Norris Legislative Chamber. Senators, the afternoon session is about to reconvene. Please check in. Senators, we're encouraging people to return to the Chamber. It's 1:40. We're about to reconvene. Thank you. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: I have a quorum present, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Do you have any items for the record, or messages?

CLERK: I have nothing at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. Mr. Clerk, where were we when we recessed, please?

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 608 on Select File. Senator Bromm had moved to amend with AM2005. Senator Beutler had moved to amend Senator Bromm's amendment with AM2039.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. On with discussion of that amendment. There were several lights on. There are two on currently, Senator Beutler and Senator Baker. Senator Beutler to continue with discussion on AM2039.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Cudaback, members of the Legislature, you'll recall that 1739 (sic--AM2039) just does one thing, and that is to make applicable to LB 775 the minimum wage provision that you and I put in on General File, which is \$8.70 per hour.
