been getting better and better for the owners of corporations and those who make money from the actions of corporations. And this last year, and this latest action with dividends, is no different. Those who own the corporations and are getting the dividends are going to get an enormous benefit here. Isn't it time that we start sharing more of this with the common worker? On General File, I thought we were getting there. I thought we were going to pay some additional share out of these corporations who are applying for LB 775 benefits, who are the same corporations that are going to get these dividend benefits now. It would seem logical that there ought to be some sharing, and that we ought to do better at the bottom end, that we ought not to be expanding our welfare programs to take care of the people at the bottom end. Business wants us to have smaller government, but they put more people in a position that they can't make a living, and at the same time oppose a minimum wage, and at the same time oppose even a minimum wage in return for tax benefits like LB 775. So I thought perhaps that the additional benefit of the dividends going to the owners of corporations would be some additional incentive for you to see the equity of doing right by the common worker. Thank you.
