SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Landis. Senator Brashear, followed by Senator Raikes and Beutler.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. President, thank you. Members of the body, as Senator Landis' words are ringing in my ears: not now, not this form; I don't think we send this signal at this point in time in our deliberation. You rejected this concept before lunch. I urge you to do it after lunch. Please vote no. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Raikes. Is Senator Raikes on the floor? Yes he is.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President and members. Senator Beutler, I was interested in your comments about the program evaluation group. And I probably don't have the current name there. But is there some reason now...a question for Senator Beutler, if I might.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, would you respond?

SENATOR RAIKES: Is there some reason now that the Program Evaluation Unit could not pick as an area of interest part of the Department of Revenue, and do an evaluation?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator, we have no authority with respect to confidentiality provisions that are protective of most Department of Revenue programs, if you're talking about tax programs.
