SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Jensen, Senator Janssen, Senator Don Pederson, Senator Johnson, Senator Mossey. Senators Schrock, Stuhr, Kremer, and Hartnett. The house is under call. Senators Beutler and Thompson. Thank you. Senator Johnson and Senator Mossey, please check in. The house is under call. Senator Stuhr. Senator Hartnett. All members present or accounted for. The question before the body is adoption of AM2054 to AM2005. All in favor of that motion vote aye, opposed nay.
