SENATOR CUDABACK: The Rule 7, Section 10, gives the presiding officer the opinion it is that full and fair debate has not been afforded. I rule that there has been a full and fair debate. The motion before the body is, shall cloture be invoked? All in favor...it does require 33 votes, I might add. Correct, Mr. Clerk? The motion is, shall cloture be invoked? All in favor of such motion vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 7 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to invoke cloture.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Cloture has been invoked. We will now vote on the Bromm amendment. Voting on AM2005. All in favor of this amendment vote aye, those opposed nay. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 38 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senator Bromm's amendment to the bill.
