CLERK: Madam President, the next bill, LB 743, Senator Mossey, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7101, Legislative Journal page 1274.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Madam President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 743

SENATOR SCHIMEK: You've heard the motion. All in favor say aye. All opposed. The motion carried.

CLERK: Madam President, Senator Smith would move to amend. Senator, AM1241.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Smith, you're recognized to open on your amendment.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Madam President. And, Mr. Clerk, I would like to withdraw AM1241.

CLERK: The next amendment, Senator Smith, AM1484. (Legislative Journal page 1459.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Senator Smith, you're recognized.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Madam President and members. AM1484 is the result of several meetings, a lot of discussion in terms of the do not call list in telemarketing. It is a reflection of some realities that exist. There are, as you will see on the computers, there are a series of amendments that will address AM1484. Some of those I believe make it a better amendment.
