if...I mean maybe it'd be a novel concept that we actually do something that doesn't require a penalty, that somehow I suppose that organizations, telemarketers that belong to this group actually are good actors and believe that if they are on...if a person sends in their name to be put on the no-call list, they are put there.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Excuse me, could I ask for people to keep their conversations down a little bit. Thank you.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Senator Bourne. This helps make my point that I'm trying to be the middle ground here in terms of offering a situation with some teeth, not the Direct Marketing Association that I still receive complaints on, and the reality is that the status quo is not working. Now Senator Bourne talks about the federal list and its application, and I've acknowledged that fact. But the fact is I'm not...well, I'm certain that it will not work for intrastate phone calls. And when you look at the whole issue, the fact is we need to do something. And four years ago when I did not vote for whatever bill it was that established the state's do not call list because it was a bit Draconian in some fines and a trap for the unwary, throughout those four years since then, I've been approached several times and I feel that there is a need to do something. And we have the opportunity to fashion something here that is consumer friendly, that protects one's privacy and their right to enjoy a peaceful evening without being bombarded by folks who call themselves nonprofit or who genuinely are nonprofit or commercial, for that matter, but they contract in a way that skirts the status quo requirement. And I have worked really hard to make this more user friendly, more subscriber friendly, more friendly for those who need to work in the environment, and the fact is I think we have something that's workable here. And Senator Baker and his staff have worked hard on it. My staff has worked hard on it, and I don't think that it is accurate to say that this is an unworkable situation, that we need to do this, we need to do that. If you don't support it,...
