So this doesn't work is my point. It's a nice gesture, but for whatever reason, we've had testimony in the committee in prior years, and I can remember several people saying, well, our organization belongs to this and they do adhere to it. And I don't deny that they do. I imagine they do. I have no reason not to believe them, but there's apparently a lot of people out there don't belong to this organization and don't adhere to this request. So it just doesn't...
