past can go back quite a ways when you have some sort of nexus, connection, transaction with them that allows you to make calls to them because in this bill it's very liberal in terms of how far back it can be. So established business relationships, they have the same out that every other business in Nebraska would have, but I think the point is people make no distinction between whether these callers are licensed or not and we shouldn't. So in order to create an equitable situation as between businesses and in order to meet the expectations of the people who will sign up on the list, I would recommend to you that we adopt this amendment. Thank you.
