LB 209, 572

All in favor of the motion vote aye, opposed nay. We're voting on AM2059, offered by Senator Bromm to LB 209. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 43 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Anything further, Mr. Clerk?

CLERK: No, sir.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 209 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 209 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is readvanced. Mr. Clerk, do you have any items for the record?

CLERK: I have nothing at this time, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. As the agenda states, General File, 2003 Speaker priority bills. Mr. Clerk, first item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 572, a bill by Senator Jensen. (Read title.) The bill was introduced on January 21 of this year, at that time referred to the Revenue Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments. (AM1149, Legislative Journal page 1155.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Jensen, to open on LB 572.

SENATOR JENSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. LB...and I want to thank the Speaker for putting this on the agenda. It is an important issue. LB 572 was brought to me by the Attorney General's Office. LB 572 deals with the enforcement of the model escrow statute, enacted pursuant to the tobacco Master Settlement Agreement.
