Committee to LB 65. All in favor of the question vote aye, opposed nay. The question before the body is adoption of AM0271, offered by the Natural Resources Committee to LB 65. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Committee amendments have been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of advancement of LB 65 itself to E & R Initial. Seeing no lights on, Senator Preister, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR PREISTER: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. In addition to thanking the other people that I did, I would like to thank the Natural Resources committee counsel, Jody Gittins, for her work on this bill, and all the work that we've done in the committee.
