SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 720.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 720. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed to the motion say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 720 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Heard the motion to advance LB 720 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor of the motion say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced to E & R for engrossing.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Hartnett, I understand you'd like to pass over LB 721. Is that right, Senator?

SENATOR HARTNETT: (Inaudible).

CLERK: Well, Senator, LB 720 is advanced.

SENATOR HARTNETT: LB 721 (inaudible).
