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LB 270, 720, 721

Senator. But go ahead with LB 721. I'm sorry.

CLERK: That's all right. Thank you, Senator. I'm sorry if I've misunderstood our conversation. Senator Mossey, LB 721, I have Enrollment and Review amendments pending. (AM7146, Legislative Journal page 1981.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: We thank you, Senator Hartnett, for that. Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 721.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments to LB 721. All in favor of that motion say aye. Opposed to the motion say nay. They are adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on LB 721, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 721 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Heard the motion to advance LB 721 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. It is advanced. As the agenda states, we did change LB 270, the bottom of the list on the front page. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 270 on General File, a bill originally introduced by Senator Brashear. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 13 of this year, at that time referred to the Judiciary Committee. Bill was advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM0317, Legislative Journal page 479.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Brashear, you're recognized to open on LB 270.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. LB 270 modifies Nebraska's current hate crimes statute to
