SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Mr. Speaker, I respectfully request a call of the house and a roll call vote.

SPEAKER BROMM: A call of the house has been requested. All in favor of the house going under call please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 32 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to place the house under call.

SPEAKER BROMM: The house is under call. Members, please report to the Chamber and record your presence. Unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. The house is under call. Senator Redfield. Senator Price, if you'd please check in. Senator Cudaback, if you would please record your presence. Senator Schimek, Senator...Senator Synowiecki, what manner would you like to vote?

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Regular order.

SPEAKER BROMM: Roll call, regular order?

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: Roll call vote. Yes.

SPEAKER BROMM: Regular order, roll call. Mr. Clerk. Members, the question before us is the adoption of AM2104. Please call the roll, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 2059.) 14 ayes, 18 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. I raise the call. Mr. Clerk, do you have further items on the bill?

CLERK: I do, Mr. President. Senator Tyson would move to amend. (AM2106, Legislative Journal page 2060.)
