CLERK: Mr. President, LB 48, it's a bill by Senator Chambers. Mr. President, Senator Chambers, first of all I have AM1978 with a note you'd like to withdraw that, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: That's correct.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

CLERK: Senator Bromm, AM2060 with a note you'd like to withdraw that, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn.

SPEAKER BROMM: Mr. Clerk, I believe, is that Senator Stuhr's amendment?

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is, Senator.

SPEAKER BROMM: Yes.

CLERK: I am sorry. It does say Senator Stuhr. I am sorry, Senator.

SENATOR STUHR: That is correct.

CLERK: Withdraw, Senator?

SENATOR STUHR: Yes, please.

CLERK: Thank you. Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to amend with AM2081. (Legislative Journal page 2061.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on your amendment.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, at last we are here. This bill and what it attempts to do or is intended to do has been pending for some time. In order to make it clear why the bill had not been acted on earlier, Senator Bromm had had some discussions with the Governor about other matters and this bill came up. And Senator
