that's the only one that we can think of. Today, you know, I had a call from a woman who I believe has testified before the General Affairs Committee several times and she is a counselor for gambling addiction, and she has expressed concern about having the gambling addiction money provided for, and I have assured her a number of times that we would want to do that and would do that in the enabling legislation. But beyond that, this is really interesting, she said to me, she said, you know, I hope you guys pass this bill this year. She said,...

SENATOR BAKER: One minute.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: ...I know I work with gambling addiction, but this is not going to be making that much difference in what we already have. And I hear it from people all the time that we need to do this and we need to give it to the people to vote. She says, I am very afraid of what kind of gambling that we are going to get unless the Legislature does something in a more limited form. Now this is a woman who works with gambling addiction and that is what she told me. No bill is going to be perfect from any one person's perspective. We're all...we all have to make some allowances for people in other parts of the state, from people who don't like gambling, for people who think the money should be spent in one way or the other. We all have to make some compromises here and...
