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of another state that's within us and it just seems to me that we're either going to define the solution or we're going to get it rammed down our throats, either by the state of Iowa or by a petition. I would prefer that we define the solution. Thank you.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Brown. Senator Tyson.

SENATOR TYSON: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. I rise to oppose a return to Select File. I don't know what difference it makes. I do admire Senator Brashear's general rhetorical approach. He sets up straw men and then he whacks them down. He compares Las Vegas casino, the Venetian, one thing, the other, with such dens of iniquity here in Nebraska as bingo in the Sacred Heart's basement where the senior...God knows what goes on at the senior citizen center. Bingo, my God, the depravity that you find in your own backyard. The difficulty with Senator Brashear's argument, indeed the purport of this bill, is that this is not a tenable idea for the state of Nebraska. I do admire some of the draftsmanship. Nebraska Future Trust Fund, wonderful words with a heavy semantic impact, futures and trust. The money that would go into that would be dedicated to economic development and community improvement. One way to improve the community would be to dedicate that money to those people who are addicted to gambling. Another use would be to offset some of the damages brought on by the bankruptcies that are attendant with increased gambling. We could do something about the unemployment that results when people switch custom from the restaurants and the entertainment centers that they now frequent to casinos, and that has already happened in Omaha and they think that a cure for that ill is to get sicker themselves. I don't understand that. We just had some contention here in this body about increasing sales tax. Another use for the Nebraska Futures Trust...God, what a wonderful title...Futures Trust would be to compensate for the loss of sales tax going to the casinos, unless we can find some way to tax every pull of the lever. I don't even think you pull levers anymore. I haven't been to one of these things. Do you pull levers or do you just push buttons? I read somewhere the other day where you don't even have to buy chips anymore. You can use your credit card in the machine. I have been in only
