SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. You've heard the closing. The question then is the return to Select File of LA...of 11CA, LR 11CA. All in favor please vote aye, and opposed nay. Senator Brashear, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, I'd request a roll call vote, please.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Brashear is requesting a roll call vote. Mr. Clerk, proceed with the roll call.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 2078.) 25 ayes, 21 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return the bill.

SPEAKER BROMM: The motion is successful. Senator Brashear, you'd be recognized to open on the amendment for which the bill has been returned.

SENATOR BRASHEAR: Mr. Speaker, members of the body, I think there's nothing more to be said. The amendment is as we have had the debate to this point in time. And I would urge the adoption of the amendment and the advancement of the bill. Thank you.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Senator Janssen.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. Speaker, members. The state of Nebraska should be in control of these revenues. That way, everyone in this state would share from those revenues, in one way, shape, or form. That is what the commission that Senator Brashear has advocated...I guess it could be in this body. I would just as soon see it that way. The commission would give grants, award those grants to everywhere in the state. It
