SPEAKER BROMM: The amendment is not adopted. Mr. Clerk, do you have anything further on the bill?

CLERK: Just the motion to readvance, Mr. President, at this time.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Mossey.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. Speaker, I move the advancement of LB...correction, LR 11CA to E & R for engrossing.

SPEAKER BROMM: You've heard the motion. Senator Chambers. Excuse me. Senator Tyson, your hand was up for what reason?

SENATOR TYSON: Request a roll call vote in regular order.

SPEAKER BROMM: Okay. We'll have debate on the motion to advance first, and then we'll do that, Senator Tyson. Senator Chambers, you're recognized.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: (Laugh) Point of...was the request for a roll call vote as to whether I'm going to be allowed to speak, or just what? (Laughter) In the interest of being collegial, I will not speak, if that's the way you feel about it. Thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Senator Landis. Senator Landis, your light was on. The question before us is the advancement again of LR 11CA to E & R for engrossing. And I believe a roll call vote was requested. Mr. Clerk. Proceed with a roll call vote on the advancement to E & R for engrossing.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 2079-2080.) 21 ayes, 20 nays on the readvancement.

SPEAKER BROMM: The bill does not readvance. Members, on the agenda, the category of motions in order filed with the Clerk after LR 11CA should tell you there have been four motions filed, four different bills involving motions: LB 285A, LB 596, LB 608A, and LB 48.
