but don't touch this program, this is the worthwhile one? And they are all probably pretty worthwhile, but I think enough is enough. And I've got some, if this is going to be an extended debate, I've got some additional numbers about how this smoking cessation information is available on the Internet, quite honestly. And when we heard the debate over this issue earlier, it kept...they kept focusing on kids. Well, that's one component of the plan, of the tax-free Nebraska...or Tobacco Free Nebraska, but that's not the only thing. You can go on the Internet. I read you some of the excerpts from the personal quit kit that one of my staff members, who works with me, had obtained that came from I don't know if it's Idaho or...or Utah, it was, and we talked about that at the very first round, that the, you know, they hired this firm from Utah to send this thing out here to Nebraska on how to quit. But over the lunch hour I went on to the Internet and I typed in several things, and one of them I searched for "stop smoking," and 2,990,000 sites came up that can tell you how to stop smoking. That's a lot. Didn't cost \$3 million a year. Then I typed in, I erased that and I typed in "smoking cessation"--521,000 hits; 521,000 sites came up that said on how you can go about smoking cessation. So I typed in "quit tobacco"--307,000 sites. Then I typed in "smoke free"--3 million sites. Then I typed in "smoking addictions"--100,000 sites; "smoking ban," this is for Senator Thompson--375,000 sites; and then "no smoking," this was really for Senator Thompson--4,700,000 hits. So I guess my point is, is that this program, while I understand it has won national awards and that...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...but, I mean, we have to make some cuts somewhere. And I suggest to you that a lot of this information is available from other sources. And I think that Senator Raikes had the right idea when we eliminated the funding for this some weeks ago. And I'm going to oppose this amendment, the motion to return, and if the motion is successful, I'll oppose the amendment itself, and not because it's not a good program. And, again, I had mentioned several times, if you want to fund this through the settlement money, I said earlier LB 672, I guess it was LB 692, as I understand millions and
