millions and millions of dollars come out of that fund, that the fund has generated or it's funded by the tobacco settlement. If you want to fund the smoking cessation, let's do it out of that. I don't believe we should use General Fund money or an additional tax increase to fund this program. If Senator Landis wants to amend this amendment so that it comes out of the Tobacco Trust Fund, let's do that, and I'll support it. But I think enough is enough.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. Senator Baker, motion to return.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. I'm going to echo some of what Senator Bourne just said. This is getting scary when he and I agree on too many things here. The fourth time isn't the charm, as far as I'm concerned. Fourth time isn't going to do it. We're talking about General Fund money. He took the words right out of his mouth as he ended there. Let's take this out of the Tobacco Settlement Trust Fund. That's where this money belongs to be taken out of. And we can do that next year if that's what we want to do. I'm going to go back to a little talk I had this morning, a little self-discipline here wouldn't hurt anything at all. At this time it's just \$405,000 of self-discipline out of the General Fund. As I recall, this fund was started with \$7 million on an annual basis. We took that money away from it in one of the special sessions, whenever, a couple of years back. They weren't using it. Then they wanted \$3 million. Now we're back again, \$405,000. I oppose the amendment. It's taking the money out of the wrong place. If we do it at all, I would support it taken out of the Tobacco Trust Fund settlement money but not out of the General Fund. So, for those reasons, I oppose the amendment, hope the body does likewise. Thank you.
