those opposed nay. We're voting on adoption of AM2108, which is a Select File amendment to LB 596. Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on adoption of the Select File amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The amendment has been adopted. Senator Mossey, for a motion.

SENATOR MOSSEY: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 596 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 596 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, next agenda item.

CLERK: Mr. President, LB 608A. Senator Landis would move to return the bill for specific amendment, AM2116. (Legislative Journal page 2083.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, to open on your motion to return LB 608A to Select File for a specific amendment.

SENATOR LANDIS: Thank you, Senator Cudaback. Through the propitious scheduling of these measures by Senator Bromm, this is in fact the A bill to what we just did. When you do this kind of work, and in fact you have now a more complex body of obligations for us to do, we need people to keep checking the paperwork to make sure that people are doing as they're supposed to do. And we need a couple more people to do the paperwork to make sure that the expensing is done correctly, and that we in fact protect that \$6 million of tax base. So we need two revenue workers, one an operations clerk, and one a specialist. It will cost about \$65,000 for FY 2004, and about the same amount in FY 2005. I would ask for the adoption of the amendment, \$65,000 a year, two revenue workers to basically do the work that would allow us to protect that \$6 million of tax base.
