done in this amendment is we have used "person" interchangeably. Person can be an individual; person can be a corporation. So when it says, state clearly the identity of the person initiating the call, does it mean, hi, I'm Bob and I'm calling to solicit you? Or does it mean, hi, I'm Bob from ABC company soliciting you? We don't know. And when you're talking about a penalty, it matters. And so again, I suggest to you that here at the late hour, that we're going to forward a bill on that is not properly drafted. We have spent more time trying to figure out how to get the bill across. We heard on General File 100 times from Senator Baker, let's just move it across to Select and we'll work with everybody concerned, and then we'll go from there. Well, this is what we get. And now Senator Baker again tonight said, let's move this across to Final Reading. Well, the only redeeming quality, or the only redeeming factor, as I see it, is that there's a delayed effective date. But think of the inefficiencies of having to introduce a bill, having to prioritize the bill...because you know as well as I do that our next session is going to be a short one, and we have a number of bills to discuss. So the delayed effective date really isn't anything at all, because we won't be able to introduce legislation to correct this. And yet here we are, the day before...and this has to go tonight or it doesn't go this year. And they're being...they're asking us to move a bill that I consider flawed. Senator Chambers takes pride in reviewing all these bills, and I suggest that he hasn't read this one, and some of the attorneys here haven't read this either. Senator Aguilar probably hasn't read this. But anyway, again, I suggest to you that...I'm going to support this amendment, but it is broader, this amendment carves out a broader exception than those certified as 501(c)(3)...

SPEAKER BROMM: One minute.

SENATOR BOURNE: ...companies, or 501 nonprofit companies. So what they're asking us to do tonight is to pass over a bill that is not drafted properly. That's my opinion. Again, I'm going to support Senator Synowiecki's amendment. I know that makes it better. I'm going to support Senator Smith's amendment that delays the effective date of this. But again, I suggest to you, this is redundant. We don't need this. It makes...common
