LB 320A

Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2096-2097.) Vote is 2 ayes, 35 nays on the passage of the bill, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 320A does not pass. Mr. Clerk. Madam Clerk, next.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion with respect to LB 574 is a motion to dispense with the at-large reading.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, for what purpose?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Point of order. Was that a bill with the emergency clause?

SENATOR CUDABACK: It was, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: If it failed to pass with the emergency clause, should a vote be taken to see if it would pass without the emergency clause? I'm just curious.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 320AE. Senator Chambers, your point is well taken. We will take a second vote. Mr. Clerk. Mr. Clerk, read the motion.

CLERK: Well, Mr. President, the motion is the passage of LB 320A without the emergency clause attached.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion. All in favor of the motion vote aye; opposed to the motion vote nay. Have you all voted the way you care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal pages 2097.) 1 aye, 37 nays, Mr. President, on the passage of LB 320 (sic) without the emergency clause.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 220 (sic) does not...LB 320A does not pass with the emergency clause stricken. Madam Clerk, next item.
