LB 622

SPEAKER BROMM: All provisions of law relative to procedure having been complied with, the question is, shall LB 622 pass with the emergency clause attached? All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2121.) Vote is 28 ayes, 17 nays, 3 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, on passage of the bill with the emergency clause attached, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: The bill does not pass with the emergency clause. Since it failed to pass with the emergency clause, we'll proceed to vote on the bill without the emergency clause. All in favor of passing the bill without the emergency clause please vote aye, and opposed nay. Please record.

ASSISTANT CLERK: (Record vote read, Legislative Journal page 2122.) Vote is 29 ayes, 17 nays, 2 present and not voting, 1 excused and not voting, Mr. President.

SPEAKER BROMM: LB 622 does pass without the emergency clause. Mr. Clerk, do you have a motion?

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Raikes would move to reconsider the vote on the passage of LB 622 with the emergency clause attached.

SPEAKER BROMM: (Visitors introduced.) Senator Raikes, you're recognized to open on your reconsideration motion.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. I ask you to reconsider the emergency clause vote on LB 622. The body has decided that LB 622 will become law. You have had an opportunity and have used it to express your opposition in the vote that you made, but the bill is going to pass, it is going to become part of law, so what I ask you now is to vote for the emergency clause so that we can make the law that we have agreed to adopt work properly. So again, I ask that you vote for LB 622 with the emergency clause attached. Thank you.
