SPEAKER BROMM: LR 197 is adopted. And while the Legislature is in session and capable of transacting business, I do propose to sign and do sign LR 189, LR 190, LR 191, LR 192, LR 195, LR 196, and LR 197. Next item on the agenda, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I now have a series of confirmation reports, the first by the Business and Labor Committee, found on page 2073 of the Journal. This involves three appointments to the Boiler Safety Code Advisory Board.

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Vrtiska.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. Members of the body, it pleases me to bring to you the appointments of Mr. Robert Hill to the Boiler Safety Code Advisory Board. He is a reappointment by the Governor to this board. Also Mr. William Yates. Mr. Hill appeared before the committee and answered the questions that were posed to him. Mr. William Yates is also a reappointment to the advisory board. Mr. Yates also appeared. Mr. Hix, who was appointed, did not appear, but he had a...Senator Kermit Brashear's aide came down and gave us the information that was...we required, and so the board unanimously voted in favor to bring their appointments before the Legislature this morning...or this afternoon.
