FLOOR DEBATE

May 30, 2003

SPEAKER BROMM: Report is adopted. Next item, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, I have a second report from Business and Labor involving the appointment of Loren Lindahl to the Commission of Industrial Relations. (Legislative Journal page 2074.)

SPEAKER BROMM: Senator Janssen. Yeah, I'm sorry. Senator Vrtiska, excuse me.

SENATOR VRTISKA: Thank you, Mr. Speaker. We bring before you the appointment, Governor's appointment, of Mr. Loren Lindahl to the Commission on Industrial Relations. Mr. Lindahl appeared before the committee, answered the questions that were posed to him. He appeared to be qualified. The only chink we could find in his armor was the fact he used the Speaker, Curt Bromm, as a reference, but we overlooked that and the committee decided to forward his nomination to the floor. Wich that, thank you, Mr. Speaker.

SPEAKER BROMM: Thank you, Senator Vrtiska. Is there any further discussion? Seeing none, the question then is the adoption of this report from the Business and Labor Committee. All in favor vote aye, and opposed nay.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal page 2130.) 37 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the confirmation report as offered by the Business and Labor Committee.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next confirmation report is offered by the General Affairs Committee. It involves the appointment of four individuals to the Advisory Commission on Compulsive
