Committee. All in favor of the motion vote aye, those opposed nay. Voting on adoption of the confirmation report offered by the Health and Human Services Committee. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Record vote, Legislative Journal pages 2131-2132.) 36 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the report as offered by Health and Human Services.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The report has been adopted. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next report is by Natural Resources. It involves an appointment to the Power Review Board.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, Chairman of that committee, you're recognized to open on your report.

SENATOR SCHROCK: Mr. President, members of the Legislature, on May 22, Mark Hunzeker appeared in front of the Natural Resources Committee to be appointed to the Power Review Board. He served a term when Kay Orr was Governor, and has just completed a four-year term. He's an attorney in Lincoln. He has also served on the Accountability and Disclosure Commission. I would recommend that we vote positive on Mark Hunzeker's appointment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Schrock. You've heard the opening on the first report offered by the Natural Resources Committee. Open for discussion on that report. Seeing no lights on, Senator Schrock, do you wish to close on that report? He waives the opportunity. The question before the body is adoption of the confirmation report offered by the Natural Resources Committee. All in favor vote aye, opposed nay. Voting on the first report offered by the Natural Resources Committee. Record please, Mr. Clerk.
