SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. Senator Engel, did you wish to address this motion to unbracket? Or was that on by mistake?

SENATOR ENGEL: I waive.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Engel. Mr. Clerk, what is the motion?

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Bourne would ask unanimous consent to unbracket LB 208.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Any objection? Seeing none, so ordered. Mr. Clerk, next motion.

CLERK: Mr. President, the next motion for consideration this morning by the Legislature is the motion to adopt permanent rules.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, in the absence of the Chairman of the Rules Committee, you're Vice Chairman, you're recognized to open on the motion to adopt the permanent rules. Senator Baker.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I move that we adopt permanent rules for the Ninety-Eighth Legislature, Second Session.

CLERK: Mr. President, pursuant to that motion, I now have an amendment from the Rules Committee, an amendment proposed. And copies have been distributed. They're on your desk. It's entitled Performance Audit Committee draft of proposed rules changes. That amendment is proposed by the Rules Committee, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, you're recognized to open on that amendment to the permanent rules.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Cudaback and members. As the
